ARTICLES

To find journal articles on physical therapy topics, start searching one of the following recommended databases. These databases are available to you from the Hunter College Libraries at http://library.hunter.cuny.edu/hpl/health_db.html.

InfoTrac Health Reference Center

Locate full-text articles from a wide variety of publications including practitioner journals, popular magazines and scholarly periodicals. Topics covered include equipment used in physical therapy, evaluation of services, marketing trends as well as standards in the field.

CINAHL

Articles on all aspects of physical therapy are addressed in this nursing database. Some full-text may be linked or you can locate the print copy of the journal using CUNY+.

Medline

This is the premier database for medical research. All major medical journals are indexed in this source. While some articles are available in full text, many are not and must be located in print in the library.

Academic Search Premier

Academic Search Premier covers a wide variety of disciplines including indexing some of the core medical journals. Full text is available for many articles and it may be an excellent source to find articles that address legal, social and economic aspects of a physical therapy.
