The principal library of the Park Avenue Building, which accommodates 256 students, is on the fifteenth floor, at the 33rd Street side. In the downtown library there will be 30,000 volumes, including 5,000 science books, 12,500 history texts. and 10,000 volumes providing history and English background. The library at 68th Street will be located in the North Gym, and will accommodate 112 students. There will be 25,000 books on display shelves, and 10,000 in stacks. In former locker rooms there will be an office for Miss Plumb, Assistant

Administration Offices. Laboratories, Library Are Located Downtown TO OCCUPY 31/2 FLOORS 68th Street Library To Be e Located in North Gym; Will Hold 35,000 Books A 0-Occupation of the temporary quarters, at 2 Park Avenue, will take place this week. The administrative offices of the College, the science laboratories, the principal library and classrooms of various departments will be located in the downtown structure. The College will occupy the second, third, fifteenth and one-half of the sixteenth floors. On the second floor, at the front of the building, are the offices of the Geology

and Physics Departments, the Dean's Office and the Bureau of Occupations. On the 33rd Street side are Council Room and the office of BULLETIN. At the west end is a large lunch room; near the 32nd Street side is the Journalism Office. On Park Avenue near 32nd Street are the Physics laboratories.
