These new towers enliven our spirit and ennoble our work.

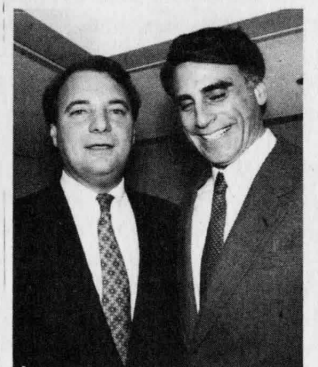
They give us a sense of where we are and who we are yet to be.
