COLLECTION SUMMARY

The Women's Research and Development Fund records (1985-1996) provide evidence of some of the actions undertaken by CUNY following the sex discrimination lawsuit *Melani et al. v. The Board of Higher Education*. The fund, part of the class action settlement in favor of women faculty members, provided research support and educational and professional development opportunities. The records contain research grant proposals (both funded and unfunded), administrative correspondence, and documentation of the Women's Leadership Institute and Mentoring Program. The collection documents the scholarship and artistic endeavors of CUNY's women faculty.

Collection Details

Historical Note

Citing Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Section 1983 of the U.S. Code, Lilia Melani, an English professor at Brooklyn College, and twenty-two other women faculty and administrators filed a class action lawsuit in 1973 accusing the Board of Higher Education of discrimination at the City University of New York. The case, *Melani et al. v. The Board of Higher Education*, was heard in federal court and in his 1984 decision judge Lee Gagliardi of the Southern District of New York ruled against CUNY citing the inequity of women's salaries in comparison to their male colleagues with the same credentials. On average women had been paid \$2,000 less than men.

The bulk of the multi-million dollar financial settlement went to back pay for instructional staff and as compensation for individuals not hired who had been discriminated against during the hiring process. Another part of the settlement, a fund for research projects and educational programs with an initial balance of \$100,000 quickly grew to \$300,000 through the donations of the back pay won by some of the faculty members. This fund, the Women's Research and Development Fund, began to distribute money in 1985 under the oversight of a board of directors comprised of faculty (including Melani) and CUNY administrators.

The fund launched its first grant competition in Spring 1986. Women faculty could apply for awards up to \$5,000 each. Dozens of readers from across CUNY evaluated applications and the board awarded 31 grants. No competition was held for 1986-1987 because of logistical issues.

Administrative staff were included in the fund's next initiative, the Women's Leadership Institute (organized by Dr. J. Juechter of Bronx Community College), held on June 21-27, 1987. The Spring 1987 grant competition expanded to provide 27 educational grants for graduate study for adjunct faculty in addition to the 18 research grants awarded that year. A mentoring program pairing junior colleagues with senior faculty and administrators, including provosts, deans, vice presidents, and department heads began in Spring 1989 and continued into 1991. Seventeen mentors (including New York City Technical College President Ursula Schwerin who served as the board's chair) worked with 57 mentees.

In the early 1990s the fund reached a turning point and the board decided to award fewer grants over a longer period of time as opposed to awarding many grants and quickly depleting the fund. The focus narrowed to proposals that were women-specific in their scope. In lieu of readers, the board itself now evaluated all of the applications which were fewer in number. There were seven grants awarded in

1991-1992, eight in 1993-1994, nine in 1994-1995, ten in 1994-1995, and five in the final year of 1995-1996.

Collection Description (Scope and Contents)

The records of the Women's Research and Development Fund document the scholarship and artistic endeavors of CUNY's women faculty from 1985 to 1996 that were made possible by the settlement of *Melani et al. v. The Board of Higher Education*. A comprehensive history written by Lucinda R. Zoe and Lillia Melanie can be found in Box 1, Folder 1; it includes a few brief reflections from some faculty members about the fund's impact.

The bulk of the collection consists of a decade's worth of research grant applications, for research, arts, other projects submitted by CUNY women faculty as well as the organizational papers of the Board of Directors who managed the Fund. With these 14 boxes, researchers can examine the breadth of scholarly interests of women faculty who worked at CUNY during second wave feminism.

Over 200 women sought funding for research, creative, and curriculum projects. The results were papers, performances, new curriculum, and initiatives to involve women in traditionally male fields such as computer science. The collection inventory lists the names of applicants, their CUNY affiliation, and the title of their proposal. The faculty members represented nearly every academic subject area and proposals typically include curriculum vitae. Grant outcomes/deliverables are often included.

The remainder of the collection provides the organizational papers of the Women's Research and Development Fund including correspondence and administrative files which document the behind-the-scenes work of coordinating and facilitating the specialized programs offered by the fund. The Women's Leadership Institute and Mentoring Program files contain applications, anonymous attendee evaluations for the Leadership Institute, and lists of mentors and mentees.

Arrangement

The grant applications are organized chronologically with accepted proposals (awardees) filed separately from rejected proposals. (Rejected proposals are only available for years 1993 to 1996; prior years may be located in the files of Dean Waters).

Leadership Institute applications are filed in alphabetical order by last name. Mentoring program files are divided into sections for mentors and mentees, with files organized alphabetically by last name.

Immediate Source of Acquisition

The collection was transferred to Hunter College by Gloriana B. Waters, Vice Chair of the Women's Research and Development Fund, in 2000.
